

NATIONAL COUNCIL DELEGATE

Job Description

Purpose: To represent Girl Scouts - Sybaquay Council at the National Council Session of Girl Scouts of the U.S.A. to determine the direction Girl Scouting will take throughout the country.

Accountable to: Members of Girl Scouts - Sybaquay Council

Responsibilities:

1. Attend all local meetings scheduled for orientation and preparation prior to the National Council Session.
2. Study the agenda of the National Council.
3. Be informed on the council's point of view about actions to be taken by the National Council, but vote independently in the best interests of Girl Scouting as a whole.
4. Attend all meetings of the National Council.
5. Be familiar with the rules of parliamentary procedure and how to use them.
6. Report and interpret National Council actions to local council constituencies.
7. Be prepared to participate in the role of delegate for the entire three-year period for which elected.

Qualification:

1. Be a citizen of the United States of America.
2. Be a currently registered member of the Girl Scout Movement.
3. Be 14 years of age or older.
4. Possess the ability to think and act wisely as a member of the deliberative body setting broad directions.
5. Be able to represent the points of view of various ethnic, racial, educational, civic, religious and socioeconomic groups.
6. Be willing to prepare thoroughly on the issues and business that will come before the National Council Sessions.

Term: Three years.
